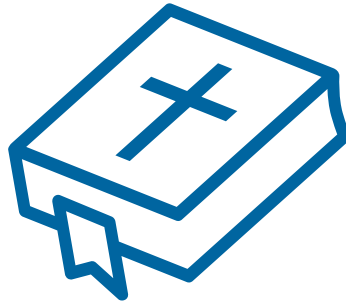

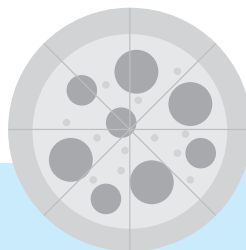

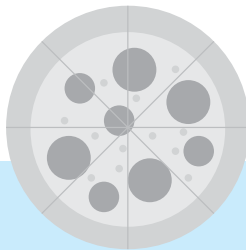

Questions for Younger Kids

But God made the earth by his power; he founded the world by his wisdom and stretched out the heavens by his understanding. (Jeremiah 10:12)

The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it; for he founded it on the seas and established it on the waters. (Psalm 24:1–2)

You, Lord, are our Father. We are the clay, you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand. (Isaiah 64:8)
I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. (Psalm 139:14)

Close with the following blessing.

May you know that God, Creator of the heavens and the earth, also created you. May you find peace knowing that you are fearfully and wonderfully made. He has made a way for you to be in relationship with Him because He loves you and He is good.
