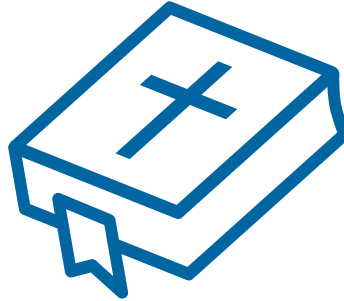

Questions for Younger Kids

1. Why didn't the Israelites want to travel through Samaria? John 4:9
2. Why wasn't Jesus supposed to talk to the woman at the well? John 4:9, 27
3. What did the woman do when she realized who Jesus was? John 4:28–29
4. How does it make you feel to know that Jesus knows you and loves you?

Questions for Older Kids

1. What did the woman do when she realized who Jesus was? John 4:28–29
2. How did Jesus draw the Samaritan woman into relationship with Him?
3. When Jesus stayed in Samaria to teach, how did the people respond? John 4:40–41
4. How did the Samaritan woman play a part in The Big God Story? John 4:28–30, 39–42
5. How can you know that Jesus knows everything about you? Psalm 139:1–6, 23–24
6. How does it make you feel to know that Jesus knows you and loves you?



BLESS

Open a Bible and read **1 John 3:19–20**:

This is how we know that we belong to the truth and how we set our hearts at rest in his presence ... we know that God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything.

Encourage everyone to take turns saying “God knows everything,” and everyone else can respond, “You are known by God.” Then switch.

Finally, speak this blessing over the group:

May you rest in the peace of being known by your Heavenly Father. May you tell others the good news of Jesus.
